I want to advise you about a new on-line application process for making requests of Procter & Gamble. Effective July 1, 2006:

- All grant and other funding requests must be made using our new on-line grant system that will be accessible from www.pg.com. This system will reduce the amount of information you need to provide to request a grant and reduce the amount of paperwork associated with completing a grant request. Telephone, paper and e-mail requests will no longer be accepted.
- All grant recipients will be required to complete an annual Partner Assessment & Community Evaluation (PACE) six months after a grant is awarded. The information on this form will be captured, in part, during the grant request process. This report will include both quantitative and qualitative information; and will help us assess the value of the grants we are making in the communities where we live and work.

Funding Requests and Timing -- Once you enter the application process via www.pg.com:

- You may begin your draft application and then submit your request upon completion.
- If you are applying for a grant from The P&G Fund, applications will be reviewed twice/year (usually October and March).
- If you are applying for corporate funding (not The P&G Fund), your request will be forwarded to the appropriate areas for review and reply. You will be notified shortly after review (usually within 30 days).

I'd like to share some information with you about our new corporate focus for giving. P&G recently completed a comprehensive review of our contributions activity and global support strategies. As a result, P&G recently introduced a new global corporate program we call Live, Learn & Thrive (LLT) which focuses on the development of children in need (ages 0-13). We will focus P&G philanthropy, expertise and technologies on this critical cause. You can learn more about LLT by visiting our website.
